PURPOSE:

To establish minimum criteria guidelines for when Road Maintenance Agreements are required for aggregate hauling.

POLICY STATEMENT:

For aggregate hauling, an individual road maintenance agreement shall be required for non-agricultural commercial hauls in excess of 200 yards of material or equivalent over a 5 or less working day period within the RM of Stanley No. 215.

FEES:

Where road maintenance agreements are required between the municipality and haulers the hauler will be required to pay the following fees;

Actual road maintenance fees as per each approved agreement	Legislated rates apply *
* section 9 of The Municipalities Regulations	

APPLICATION:

Application shall be made in writing and include the following details;

- · goods and materials to be hauled
- estimated total quantity
- · proposed route
- timeframe of haul

APPROVAL:

All Road Maintenance Agreements require approval by Council at a Regular Council Meeting.

In unusual circumstances that require time sensitive hauls, Administration shall notify the Reeve and the Councillor for the division in which the proposed haul will take place for pre-approval and the Agreement shall be submitted to the next Regular Council Meeting for approval.
